- Be willing to be accountable to stakeholders for decisions and actions taken by BCSW.
- Take account of stakeholders' needs whilst at the same time making sure that the best interests of BCSW as a whole are served.
- Be able to form constructive working relationships with other Management Group members and to play a full part in the work of the Management Group.
- Be able to form constructive working relationships with senior staff and other employees of BCSW.
- Understand the role and responsibilities of a Management Group member.
